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SCHEDULE

The American School of Bangkok (ASB) Dormitory is located on the Bangna-Trad Highway, Kilometer 15, Samutprakarn, Thailand. The Dormitory facilities are situated on the ASB Campus; with 5- and 7-day boarding is available to full-time ASB Green Valley students.

Students enrolled at ASB must complete the application forms before consideration is given for boarding privileges.

ASB students are required to adhere to a strict, no-tolerance policy for drugs, alcohol, tobacco, and violence. Failure to follow this policy and the remainder of the Dormitory rules can result in expulsion from the ASB Dormitory and/or The American School of Bangkok.

* Students who leave the Dormitory for the weekend and return on Sunday should return by 21:00. Students may return to the Dormitory on Monday morning before Flag Raising Assembly at 7:30.

Meals and Snacks

- A. Hot meals are available in the ASB Canteen Monday through Friday.
- B Snacks are served in the Dormitory lounge at 15:00 and 19:00 Monday through Friday, and at 19:00 on Saturday and Sunday.
- C. **Weekends:** Breakfast is available from 9:00-10:00. Dinner is available from 17:00-18:00
- D. Personal snacks: Students are allowed to have personal snacks in the dormitory. Hot water, microwave, and refrigerator facilities are available on the ground floor of the dormitory. No cooking or consumption of hot foods is permitted in the dormitory bedrooms.

Visitor Policies

- A. Boarding students are allowed to receive non-boarding friends in the Dormitory lounge after school, at the discretion of the house parents.
- B Friends are not allowed upstairs in the dormitory and are not allowed into students' bedrooms.
- C. Parents are allowed to visit the bedrooms of students but must show gender consideration.
- D. After school snacks and meals are prepared for the Boarding students only. In special circumstances a House Parent may give permission for a non-boarder to eat, but payment should be made before doing so.

Clothing

- A. All clothing should be clearly marked with the student's nickname. Clothing not marked cannot be returned to the proper owner.
- B. Other Recommended Clothing Items. For example (nice outfit for special occasions, appropriate bathing suit, casual clothing, sports clothing)

• Laundry

- A. Students will need to have their own clothes hangers, but will be provided with a laundry basket for laundry collection.
- B. Students are required to place the clothes they wish to be laundered in their provided basket every morning and put the rest of their clothing away.
- C. No clothes are to be left on the floor of the dormitory rooms at any time. Clothes left in the morning or overnight will be assumed abandoned and collected by a house parent for disposal.
- D. ASB house keepers accept no responsibility for the loss or damage of clothing or items left in the pockets of clothing.

Students shall follow the above rules and regulations. If a student fails to comply, he or she may be dismissed from the ASB Dormitory.
